

Middlesex DUII Cell Phone & Electronic Device Policy

1. Prohibited Activities (Recording)

The use of any device for **photographing, video recording, or voice recording** is strictly prohibited while on Middlesex DUII property. This includes, but is not limited to:

- Cell phones
- Smart Watches
- Any mechanical or telephonic recording device.

2. Permitted Usage Areas

To maintain a communal environment, devices may not be used in common areas. Usage is restricted to the following locations only:

- **Client Rooms**
- **Day Rooms**
- **Outdoors**

Use is prohibited in the **Classroom, Kitchen/Cafeteria, Recreation Rooms**, and **ALL** other common areas.

3. Quiet Hours

- **10:00 PM Cutoff:** Out of respect for other clients, device usage in all residential areas must cease at 10:00 PM.
- **Headphones:** Must be used in the permitted areas listed above to avoid disturbing the community.

4. Connectivity & Liability

- **No Wi-Fi:** MHSA does not provide internet access; clients must provide their own data.
- **Responsibility:** MHSA assumes no responsibility for the loss, theft, or damage of any personal technology or electronic devices.

Penalty: Any client found violating this policy is subject to **disciplinary action**, including **loss of phone privileges**, and **immediate dismissal** from the program.
